A-HA PLAYS IN TEL AVIV 21 JUNE. That is un-musical.

As fans we ask you to consider:

- The Palestinians beg us to boycott Israel in order to force an end to the occupation and ensure human rights.
- Israeli critics such as "Boycott from within" and the musicians David Oppenheimer and Danielle Raavitzki implores A-ha to NOT play in Tel Aviv.
- 300 Palestinian children are harassed in Israeli jails. To play in Israel is to legitimise violations against International Law and the UN Convention on Children's Rights.
- Palestinians on the West Bank and in Gaza are occupied and isolated. They cannot attend A-ha's concert, in spite of the short distance.
- Israel exploits culture as a means for disguising its violations of International Law. When international artists perform at Israeli arenas, the authorities exploit this as promotions for Israel.
- To drop the Tel Aviv concert means to support those who seek freedom. To play in Tel Aviv is to break the Palestine boycott.

As a fan of A-ha you can help Palestinians by telling the band this: A-ha, irrespective of your good intentions you will be exploited by the occupant State if you perform in Israel.
